

Bylaw No. 8 of 2003

A Bylaw of the Town of Coronach to allow the use of snowmobiles in the Town of Coronach.

WHEREAS THE Council of the Town of Coronach deems it desirable to allow snowmobiles to use certain streets in the town limits;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Town of Coronach in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. Notwithstanding the provision contained in Section 21 of the Snowmobile Act, it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile between the hours of 7:00 AM and 11:00 PM within the corporate limits of the Town of Coronach for the purposes of entering or leaving the corporate limits; excepting the following streets and alleys:


- a) Centre Street from the southerly limit of Railway Avenue to northerly limit of South Avenue, and
- b) First Avenue West from the Easterly limit of Municipal Road to the westerly limit of First Street West, and
- c) First Avenue West from the easterly limit of First Street West to Centre Street, and
- d) First Avenue East from the easterly limit of First Street East to Centre Street, and
- e) The alley in Block 5 from the northerly limit of South Avenue to the southerly limit of First Avenue West.

2. Notwithstanding Section 1, it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on the portions of Provincial Highway No. 36 for the purpose of crossing the said highway.

3. Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and liable upon summary conviction to penalties provided under the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.


This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of approval by the Highway Traffic Board.
