

Bylaw No. 1 of 2020

A Bylaw of the Town of Coronach to create a
Coronach Community Hall Committee.

WHEREAS THE Council of the Town of Coronach deems it desirable to create a Coronach Community Hall Committee;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Town of Coronach in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. A "Board" shall be appointed to administer the affairs of the said committee.
 - a. The Coronach Community Hall Board will consist of residents from the community appointed by the Council of the Town of Coronach. Board members shall be appointed for three (3) year terms.
 - b. The Board will elect a Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer.
 - c. Meetings of the Board shall be held on a regular basis at a time to be set by resolution of the Board.
 - d. A quorum for the meeting shall be one more than one half of the members, one of whom shall be the Chairperson or Vice Chairperson.
 - e. The Board shall submit to the Town Council an annual budget, which shall be subject to approval from Town Council. The Board shall also submit an annual Financial Statement.
2. The Finance of the Committee shall include the following:
 - a. The Coronach Community Hall shall be funded by the annual rental revenues from the hall account. Annual deficits must be approved by the Town Council.
 - b. All expenditures of a capital or long term nature shall be approved by the Town Council prior to being expended.
 - c. The operating funds of the Committee shall be managed by the Board of the Committee, within the approved budget of the Coronach Community Hall Committee.
 - d. Unless otherwise specified by the donor, cash donations received by or for the Coronach Community Hall Committee shall be considered as operating income, and therefore, become part of the operating funds for the year in which it was received.
3. This bylaw shall take effect and have force on the date of signing hereof.
