Bylaw 11.2019 Noise Bylaw Amendment to Bylaw 3.1988 - A Bylaw of the Town of Coronach to prohibit certain activities creating noise and to abate the incidence of noise and to restrict the hours when certain sounds can be made.

The Council of the Town of Coronach in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This bylaw may be cited as an Amendment to the Noise Bylaw 3.1988.

INTERPRETATION/LEGISLATION

2. Definitions contained in the Bylaw 3.1988 (A Bylaw of the Town of Coronach to prohibit certain activities creating noise and to abate the incidence of noise and to restrict the hours when certain sounds can be made) shall apply in this bylaw.

SCOPE OF THE BYLAW


3. This amendment replaces Section 13 of the Noise Bylaw 3.1988 with

13. Any person who contravenes any provision of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a minimum fine of Two hundred and fifty (\$250.00) Dollars to a maximum fine not in excess of Two Thousand Five hundred (\$2500.00) Dollars. Or in default of payment of a fine, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding 60 days.

This shall come into force on July 9th, 2019
