Bylaw No. 2 of 1996

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW No. 6 of 1978 KNOWN AS THE MOTOR TRAFFIC BYLAW.

Bylaw 2 of 96 THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORONACH, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, HEREBY ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Bylaw No. 6 of 1978 is amended as hereinafter set forth.
- 2. That Section 1.(1) (f) shall be amended by adding the following Section 1.(1) (f) (i):

"Person" means any owner of any vehicle in respect of which the breach was committed is liable, as well as $\frac{1}{2}$ the person who committed the breach, unless the owner proves to the satisfaction of the judge or justice of the peace trying the case that, at the time of the breach, the vehicle had been stolen from him or taken, without his consent express or implied, out of his possession or out of the possession of a person entrusted by him with its care.

Section 10 (6) Enforcement is amended by adding the following section, offence and minimum penalty to those listed:

Section 10 (5) is amended by deleting the existing section and replacing it with the following:

"In the case of a violation of any of the provisions of Section 4.(1) to 4.(13) inclusive, the penalty for each violation shall be the sum as set out in Section 10 (6). In default of the voluntary payment provided for, herein, the alleged offender shall be subject to prosecution and upon conviction to a fine or penalty in accordance with Section 10.(3)."

5 . This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of final passing thereof.
