


BYLAW NO. 3 of 1992

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 5 of 1976 KNOWN AS
THE LICENSING BYLAW.

The Council of the Town of Coronach in the Province
of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 5 of 1976 is further amended in the manner hereinafter set forth.
2. Section 6 - License Fees - is amended by deleting the words "Schedule 'A-1'" in the second line and substituting therefor the words "Schedule 'A-2'".
3. Schedule "A-2" shall be appended to and form a part of this bylaw.
4. This bylaw shall become effective on the first day of July, 1992.
