BYLAW NO.4 of 1976

A BYLAW TO REQUIRE THE PROVISION OF GRADE DESIGN ELEVATIONS AND THE ORDERLY DISPOSAL OF EXCESS DIRT IN THE WESTVIEW SUBDIVISION AND OTHER AREAS HEREINAFTER DESIGNATED.

The Council of the Village of Coronach in the PROVINCE of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Before constructing a dwelling or other structure in "Westview Subdivision", or any other area hereinafter designated by council, the owner shall give the Village timely notice of requiring design elevations (grades) for the front property line of the lot.

The Village's appointed agent shall provide the required stakes. The Village will charge a fee for the staking, such fee to be subject to change from time to time.

2. All earth excavated from the lots in the Westview Subdivision shall be disposed of as directed by the Village at no cost to the Village. In the first instance, the earth shall be disposed of on the lot to bring the lot to the required grade. Excess material shall, in general, be disposed of in other areas of the foresaid subdivision as disrected by the Village. All fill material shall be leveled and graded to provide for drainage. This regulation shall apply to all future areas as thay may be developed.
