## BYLAW NO.4 of 1995

## A BYLAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A STREET(S)

The Council of the Town of Coronach, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor and Administrator are hereby authorized to regulate or prohibit vehicular or pedestrian traffic on a street or any portion of a street for a temporary period as approved by Council.
- 2. The Council of the Town of Coronach shall cause every street that is closed pursuant to this bylaw to be marked with a sign indicating the street's closure and the hazards, if any, that would be encountered in its use.
- 3. Any person using a street closed to traffic pursuant to this bylaw does so at his own risk, has no right to recover damages in case of accident or injury and is liable for any damage or injury to the street resulting from such use.
- 4. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided for by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Coronach.
