

BYLAW No. 5

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF BYLAWS OF THE VILLAGE.

The Council of the Village of Coronach enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as "The General Penalty Bylaw" of the Village of Coronach.
2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the Village for which no other penalty is provided and which such bylaw states, shall incur the penalties herein provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any person found guilty of an infraction of any bylaw of the Village shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding one hundred dollars and costs for every offence and in default of payment, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days unless the said penalty and costs are sooner paid.
4. All penalties and fines imposed for the infraction of a bylaw shall, unless otherwise provided for, be paid to the treasurer for the public use of the Village.
