BYLAW No. 5

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF BYLAWS OF THE VILLAGE.

The Council of the Village of Coronach enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as "The General Penalty Bylaw" of the Village of Coronach.
- 2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the Village for which no other penalty is provided and which such bylaw states, shall incur the penalties herein provided.
- 3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any person found guilty of an infraction of any bylaw of the Village shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding one hundred dollars and costs for every offence and in default of payment, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days unless the said penalty and costs are sooner paid.
- 4. All penalties and fines imposed for the infraction of a bylaw a shall, unless otherwise provided for, be paid to the treasurer for the public use of the Village.
