

BYLAW NUMBER 5/77

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CORONACH, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN,
TO CLOSE A CERTAIN STREET OF RECORD IN THE MOOSE JAW LAND TITLES
OFFICE ON PLAN CX350, IN THE VILLAGE OF CORONACH, SASKATCHEWAN, IN
ORDER TO ACCOMODATE THE PROPOSED RESUBDIVISION

The Mayor and Council of the Village of Coronach, in the Province of Saskatchewan,
in open meeting, hereby enact as follows:

" All of Douglas Street lying north of the production northwesterly
of the northeasterly limit of Churchill Avenue as same are shown on
a plan of record in the Land Titles Office for the Moose Jaw Land
Registration District as Number CX350. "

TIME this 23 rd day of August 1977. WHEREAS, a notice of intention to pass
this BYLAW was published in the Assiniboia Times on August 31 st 1977 and
September 7 th 1977; and WHEREAS the adjacent property owners, G.F. Shain,
Mr. L. Petrisor and Mr. H. Legare, have been notified; and
WHEREAS no objections have been received,

MEMBERS OF COUNCIL PRESENT, AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 27th day of September 1977.
