

BYLAW NO. 5 of 1989

- A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CORONACH, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL BUILDING CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the Councils of the Town of Coronach and the Rural Municipality of Hart Butte No.11 deem it necessary to establish a Municipal Building Corporation to oversee the construction of Recreational and Cultural Facilities;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Coronach, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE - This bylaw shall be cited as the Municipal Building Corporation Bylaw.

DEFINITIONS - Wherever in this bylaw the following terms are used they shall be held to have the following meanings:

Town Council - shall mean the Council of the Town of Coronach

Rural Council - shall mean the Council of the Rural Municipality of Hart Butte No.11

APPLICATION:

- 1. There shall be appointed by the Town Council and the Rural Council, a committee which shall be known as the "Municipal Building Corporation of Coronach & District".
- 2. (a) Such Municipal Building Corporation shall consist of seven (7) members to be appointed as follows: Two (2) members of the Rural Council; one (1) member of the Town Council; and four (4) members at large who are approved by both councils.
(b) The term of appointment of each member shall be at the discretion of the Town council and the Rural Council and the appointment of any member may be terminated upon thirty (30) days written notice from the councils.
- 3. It shall be the duty of the Municipal Building Corporation to:
 - (a) Oversee the construction of all approved Recreational and Cultural facilities for the community; and,
 - (b) Ensure that any facility being constructed is constructed in such a way so as not to place any undue financial burden on the participating councils.
- 4. (a) The Municipal Building Corporation shall be authorized to make expenditures of funds which are specifically designated by the Town Council and the Rural Council for the purpose of the construction of recreational and cultural facilities.
(b) The Corporation is further authorized to expend funds received from any other source which are designated to assist in the construction of such recreational and cultural facilities.
- 5. The decision(s) of the Municipal Building Corporation regarding the construction of recreational and cultural facilities shall be binding on both the Town Council and the Rural Council.
- 6. A quorum for any meeting of the Municipal Building Corporation shall consist of at least one (1) member from each of the Town Council and Rural Council plus any two other members of the committee.
- 7. The members of the Committee shall report to the respective councils on a regular basis.
- 8. The Committee shall, at its first meeting, elect a chairman, vice-chairman, and engage a secretary and treasurer for the committee.

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- 9. All resolutions and proceedings of the committee shall be entered in the books of the Corporation to be kept for the purpose and shall be signed by the Chairman and Secretary. A copy of these minutes is to be submitted to the Town council and the Rural Council immediately after each meeting of the Committee.
- 10. The Corporation shall be subject to dissolution upon ninety (90) days notice in writing by either the Town Council or the Rural Council, notwithstanding that the Committee will be dissolved upon completion of the construction of the recreational and cultural facilities hereinbefore mentioned.
- 11. Bylaw No. 2 of 1983 is hereby repealed.
- 12. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof by both the Town Council and the Rural Council.
