BYLAW No. 6 of 1974

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CORONACH TO REGULATE PLUMBING AND DRAINAGE OF PREMISES WITHIN THE VILLAGE.

The Council of the Village of Coronach in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

- The regulations of the Department of Public Health of the Government of Saskatchewan governing plumbing and drainage shall apply to and govern all plumbing and drainage in the Village of Coronach except as hereinafter altered or added to.
- 2. Applications for a plumbing permit shall be made by the plumbing contractor on a prescribed form and be accompanied by the required fee to the Village Secretary-Treasurer.
- The fee for a permit issued shall be:
 - a) Subject to clause (b) six dollars for, or up to, the first four fixtures to be installed and one dollar for each additional fixture; for the purpose of this section fixtures shall not include floor drains, hot water tanks, softeners or other similar appurtenances; and
 - two dollars for any installation or alteration where no soil pipe is to be installed and not more than two fixtures or devices are to be erected or installed; and
 - c) two dollars for the installation of a private sewage works when not done in conjunction with plumbing inside a building; and
 - two dollars for a permanent connection of an existing plumbing system to a sewage works and/or waterworks.
- The plumbing inspector shall be the Public Health Officer of the Assiniboia-Moose Jaw Health Region No. 2 and the plumbing contractor shall notify the plumbing inspector when any installation is ready for inspection.
- All persons undertaking the installation of, repairing of, or the addition to a plumbing system shall be in possession of a minimum of a second-class plumbers status certificate issued by the Department of Labour.
- 6. Bylaw No. 5 of 1961 is hereby repealed.
