

BYLAW NO. 6 of 1982

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CORONACH IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 6 of 1978 KNOWN AS THE TRAFFIC BYLAW.

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Coronach, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting, hereby enact as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 6/78 is amended as hereinafter set forth.
2. Section 3 (1)(J) is amended by deleting the words "with First Street West" in the first line.
3. Section 3 (1.1) is amended by adding the following:
 - (b) At the intersection of First Avenue and First Street West.
4. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of its approval by the Highway Traffic Board.
