BYLAW NO. 7 of 1981

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CORONACH IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO CONTROL THE PROTECTION OF WATER SUPPLIES FROM CHEMICAL RESIDUE.

As provided for under the authority of Section 199 (4a) of the Urban Municipalities Act, the Council of the Town of Coronach in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. No person shall fill any chemical spray apparatus at the following public water sources:
 - a) the coin operated bulk water outlet,
 - b) any hydrant in the Town of Coronach.
- 2. A person who infringes any provisions of this Bylaw or fails to comply therewith is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$200.00.
