


BYLAW NO. 7 of 1997

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CORONACH
TO CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF SCRAP TIRES.

Whereas the Saskatchewan Scrap Tire Corporation has implemented a program in Saskatchewan to recycle scrap tires; therefore,

The Council of the Town of Coronach, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires in the municipal owned and operated landfill located with the boundaries of the SW 18-2-16-W2nd.
- 2. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires on any other municipal property unless specifically designated as a tire marshalling yard.
- 3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to penalties provided for by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Coronach.
- 4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on July 15, 1997.
