

BYLAW No. 8

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE OVERSEER TO DECLARE A CIVIC HOLIDAY.

The Council of the Village of Coronach enacts as follows:—

1. The Council hereby authorizes the Overseer of the Village to declare any day or part of any day except Sunday a Civic Holiday.
2. All places of business in the Village shall close and remain closed in accordance with the provisions of the said declaration with the following exceptions:
  - (a) Cafes, restaurants, and hotel dining rooms.
  - (b) Gasoline filling stations
  - (c) Hotel, e.i. that part supplying lodging to the public.
3. No person shall be guilty of an infraction of this bylaw for supplying medicines, drugs or medical appliances during the declared closing period, nor for supplying any article required for immediate use by reason of an emergency arising from sickness, personal injury, or death.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village.
