BYLAW NO. 9 of 1995

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OTHER MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES TO EACH OTHER, WHEN REQUIRED.

The Council of the Town of Coronach in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

The Town of Coronach is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the following municipalities for the purpose of providing fire protection services to each other, when required:

> R.M. of Hart Butte No. 11 Village of Fife Lake Town of Willow Bunch

R.M. of Willow Bunch No. 42 Town of Rockglen

R.M. of Poplar Valley No. 12

R.M. of Happy Valley No. 10

- The Mayor and Administrator are hereby authorized to execute the said agreement on behalf of the municipality.
- The terms of the agreement are as defined in the Agreement which is attached hereto and identified as Exhibit "A" to this Bylaw.
- This Bylaw shall come into force and have effect on the final date of passing thereof.

Date of Agreement

This Memorandum of Agreement is made this 09 day of April , 1996.

Parties to the Agreement

This Agreement is made by the following parties:

(1) The Rural Municipality of Happy Valley No. 10, Big Beaver, Saskatchewan;

and

(2) The Rural Municipality of Hart Butte No. 11, Coronach,

and

Saskatchewan;

(3) The Rural Municipality of Poplar Valley No. 12, Rockglen, Saskatchewan;

and

(4) The Rural Municipality of Willow Bunch No. 42, Willow Bunch, Saskatchewan;

and

(5) The Town of Coronach, Coronach, Saskatchewan;

and

(6) The Town of Rockglen, Rockglen, Saskatchewan;

and

(7) The Town of Willow Bunch, Willow Bunch, Saskatchewan;

and

(8) The Village of Fife Lake, Fife Lake Saskatchewan

(hereinafter referred to as the municipalities).

3. PREAMBLE

Whereas the municipalities have voluntarily expressed an interest in entering into this agreement to provide fire protection services to each other when required, from time to time; and

WHEREAS is is deemed in the best interest of the residents of the municipalities to have the ability to utilize one or more fire departments for responding to a fire, if deemed necessary,

THE following shall be agreed.

4. AUTHORITY

"local municipality" shall mean the municipality within which a fire situation is located

"local fire department" shall mean the fire department of the local municipality

The fire department of each municipality shall be authorized to attend a fire scene in each municipality for the purposes of assisting the local fire department in the local municipality.

This authority shall only be granted if a fire department is requested by the local fire department, the local municipality, or a resident thereof, to provide assistance.

5. EQUIPMENT

Each municipaltiy to the agreement shall own, maintain, and operate all equipment for their respective fire department as they deem necessary. All costs for the operation of each municipality's fire departments shall be the responsibility of the respective municipality.

6. CALL BACK

If, when attending a fire situation in a local municipality, an emergency arises in the home municipality and the equipment is called back home, the equipment responding to the local municipality shall return to the home municipality to protect the property of the home municipality. The decision to require the return of the equipment shall be at the discretion of the fire chief.

7. FEES

The municipality (or fire department, or fire association) will invoice the municipality which requested fire protection assistance for all fire fighting services provided.

The rates charged for fire fighting services wil be set annually by the each municipality to the agreement for their respective fire department. Each municipality will advise all other parties to this agreement of the said rates established, by letter, not later than February 15th in each year.

Payment of invoices rendered for one fire department responding to a call in another municipality's jurisdiction shall be guaranteed by the municipality which initiated the fire call.

8. COMING INTO FORCE

This agreement shall come into force and have effect on the date of the signing thereof by all parties to this agreement.

9. TERMINATION

Any municipality may terminate its participation to this agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other parties to the agreement.

10. Signed by the authorized signing officers of the respective municipalities on the date indicated at the beginning of this Agreement.
