WINTER SOLSTICE

The first day of winter in the Northern Hemisphere is marked by the winter solstice, which occurs on Wednesday, December 21, 2022, at 4:48 P.M. EST. For the northern half of Earth (the Northern Hemisphere), the winter solstice occurs annually on December 21 or 22. (For the Southern Hemisphere, the winter solstice occurs on June 20 or 21.) The winter solstice is the day with the fewest hours of sunlight in the whole year, making it the "shortest day" of the year. Thankfully, after we reach the winter solstice, the days begin to once again grow longer and longer until we reach the summer solstice—the first day of summer and the longest day of the year. Think of it this way: Although the winter solstice means the start of winter, it also means the return of more sunlight. It only gets brighter from here!

- Be realistic and avoid perfectionism. The holidays do not need to be perfect. Keep in my mind what the holidays are truly about- family and connection. Shop and give within your means. Give handmade, personal gifts. Holiday plans look different for everyone- try not to compare and be willing to switch plans and traditions.
- Set boundaries. Say no if you need to and be ok with your decision to say no. Avoid people and situations that bring you down or do not serve you in a positive way. Put your own mental health first.
- Stick to your healthy habits. Of course the holidays are a time to indulge and enjoy good food and spirits. However; try to continue your exercise routine, sleep hygiene, healthy meals, drinking lots of water, avoid social media if it is triggering, etc.
- Make time for yourself. Prioritize your self-care and take time outs for yourself if needed. It is ok to take a step back, take a breath and take a break.
- Recognize your triggers. Know and understand the things, people, situations that trigger you over the holiday season.
- Increase breathing exercises, meditation, yoga, stretching, muscle relaxation and positive self-talk.
- Reframe problems and put things into perspective. The holiday season is not that long over the course of the year.
- Take time to volunteer and give back to those in need and your
