

Pound Keeper Services

The Town of Coronach is seeking a **local Pound Keeper** for cats and dogs within the Town of Coronach.

The Pound Keeper duties include:

-Being the collector for stray cats and dogs within the Town, as required

-Maintaining and operating a pound

-The pound must be kept clean and in good repair

-Supplying the animal with adequate and healthy nourishment including proper shelter

-The animal would be kept at the pound keeper's residence for 72 hours and/or until the Town authorizes their release, or taken to Moose Jaw Humane Society (last resort)

All collection, maintaining and operating the pound, supplying the animal with food/water/shelter would be paid for by the pound keeper. Pound Fees per Bylaw 3.2017 would be paid to the pound keeper accordingly. If the animal requires to be taken to the Moose Jaw Humane Society (MJHS), the Town will pay mileage to the pound keeper and any MJHS pound fees required to the MJHS.
