<u>Community & Economic Development</u> -Cold calls from CDO and REDO bring businesses to Town -Storefront Grant for Commercial Businesses- \$30,000 -Demolish Centre St building- 120 Centre St; Hole in roof -Lobby for individual resident owned buildings- derelict buildings for demo- SUMA -Pursue regional opportunities and lobbying to SUMA/FCM -Look for grant opportunities to keep CDO & REDO positions, further than March 2025; regional lobbying with Town/R.M./SaskPower for coordination of funding -Utilize sign at top of main street for advertising events/functions (across from Coop) -Build Industrial Park	<u>Recreation</u> -Replace Sportsplex Roof -Complete Pool Project -Build dog park -Build Walking path -Fix museum drainage (windows- boarding up)/slope away from windows for drainage, roof/eaves repair or replace; sell doc house/boarding up door entrance in between museum/doc office -New build or relocation of the museum -Old green streetlights- be put at Poplar River Park if still have (from Downtown Project) -Add Playground Kinsmen park -Replace valves at the campground (above ground)

Gov’t yearly for repairs -Repair watering lines at the orchard -Follow-up with SaskPower for wells commissioning -Remembrance Day Banners- Centre St- apply for grant/advertise to public for sponsorship + communicate cost -Red/White/Black Poppy sidewalk- create -New handi-van that is wheelchair accessible -More incentives to keep seniors in their homes- advocate to SUMA/levels of Gov’t -Campaign to recruit more health care professionals/doctors -Put light at Transfer Site for nighttime -Finalize seniors gazebo project- May Warken -Level 1 & 2 Homecare Renos/upgrade (study) and construction -Removal of dead trees around Town (Town owned) -Offer two free transfer site days improve aesthetics
<u>Water/Sewer</u> -1 St W heading north to Hwy- replace waterline -Order/install new and refurbish sewer lift station pumps -Re-built ‘T’ section in lift station/custom -Try Acti-zyme oil/greases/fats product to help with lift station problems -Repair WTP Roof (leaking) -Finalize Downtown Revitalization Project -Dredge Lagoon? -Reservoir cleaning (recommended every 5 years) -Replace/repair five hydrants -Winch system install in lift station to install pumps easier -Inspection valves WTP by certified tech (every 2 years) -6” freezer for water line maintenance -water meters/sensors system- instead of walk sheets	<u>Public Works & Transportation</u> -Turn pile of asphalt into \$\$\$ @ Town Shop -New/used- to replace Burgundy truck -newer zero turn mower -wing attachment for grader to clean driveways (if had angle blade- wouldn’t need this) -Third employee for public works -Angle Blade for Bobcat- sidewalks -Snow blade for dump truck -snowblower/tractor for sidewalks -Mower to replace Degelman (highway mower) (circulating one like R.M. has- goes to the side) -Snow Blade for Bobcat -Purchase wheel loader -Salt/sand storage shed -Tandem truck- haul more than 1.5 loads of snow -Tamper for potholes/packing cold mix -box blade- bobcat (for snow clean-up- it would clean the ridge in the middle of the roads to allow for more efficient snow clearing)
